TERMS and CONDITIONS for Arkan Dance Company (part of The Ukrainian Academy of Dance programming).

- 1) **Period of Instruction:** The course shall consist of bi-weekly dance instruction to be held at The Ukrainian Academy of Dance, 145 Evans Ave., at the hours as determined by the Artistic Director and determined by performance and touring plans agreed to with the parents and dancers.
- 2) **Duration of Course:** The audition date for Arkan is Sunday, September 22, 2013 12:30 -2:30pm. Regularly scheduled classes will begin Monday, September 23, 2013 and finish in May 24, 2014, depending on the touring & performance schedule agreed to. Additional tuition fees may be required during the summer months to cover the costs of additional rehearsals if touring. There will be no classes during Thanksgiving, Christmas, March Break and Easter. Other cancellations are at the discretion of the Artistic Director. Arkan Dance Company will endeavor to hold all classes as are reasonably possible including the make-up of canceled classes. Summer holidays, if any, will be voted on by all members, depending on possible tour dates.
- 3) **Tuition Fees:** Tuition fees are payable to The Ukrainian Academy of Dance. Tuition fees are not discountable. If the dancer attends only once a week or only attends part of the season, the fee is like a "membership fee" to Arkan - there are no part-time discounts. ALL ARKAN DANCERS MUST PARTICIPATE IN A SECOND CLASS OF TECHNIQUE which is included in their tuition fee.
- 4) **Costume Fees:** The "rental of costumes" fee is included in the tuition fee. An unlimited number of costumes may be used, as long as security deposits are lodged.
- 5) **Registration Fee:** There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$25 per dancer.
- 6) **Cancellation, Withdrawal, and Refunds:** Those dancers who withdraw prior to commencement of classes are entitled to a full refund, less a \$25 non-refundable administrative fee. Once the dancer has been enrolled in the course of instruction, no refund will be given under this contract and the full tuition amount will be due and owing to The Ukrainian Academy of Dance. In the event that the dancer becomes unable to continue with the course of instruction because of severe injury or prolonged illness, Arkan Dance Company in its sole discretion may consider a cancellation of the contract and may refund a portion of the fees. Any such requests for refunds shall be accompanied by a signed doctor's report, written on the doctor's letterhead, stating the nature and extent of the injury or illness which prevents the dancer from continuing with the course of instruction. Refunds, or credits, if any, will be at the discretion of the Artistic Director.
- 7) **Class Attire (Hair and Dress Code):** The dancer agrees to abide by the class "dress code" as outlined at the beginning of the 2013/2014 dance season. The dancer may not be allowed to take class if not dressed properly.
- 8) **Attendance:** If the dancer is going to be absent, a minimum 1 week notice should be given at the rehearsal before or by email. In the event of sudden illness or incident leading to absence, a message should still be left with Arkan Dance Company. Giving no notice is considered an unexcused absence. In the event of lack of notice regarding attendance, the dancer is in jeopardy of not performing, touring or even belonging to Arkan Dance Company. Expulsion is at the sole discretion of the Artistic Director. Monies raised toward a tour will not be available to a dancer with 2 un-excused absences.
- 9) **Performances and calendar of events:** Once performances or other events are announced it is up to the dancer to give immediate notice if he or she is not available to attend. Notice should be given verbally to the artistic director as well as in writing on the calendar posted in the studio or via email. In the event of lack of notice regarding attendance, the dancer is in jeopardy of not performing, touring or even belonging to Arkan Dance Company should there not be immediate improvement. Also, a dancer who is never or rarely available for performances will be at risk of being asked to leave the dance company, or not be eligible for a tour. Expulsion is at the sole discretion of the Artistic Director, and without consideration of refund.
- 10) **Behavior and Conduct:** Exemplary behavior and personal conduct of all dancers and parents is expected at rehearsals, shows, fund-raisers or any other Arkan event, especially if there is a costume or Arkan logo of any kind worn.
- 11) **Disciplinary Action:** Should the dancer not be considered suitable for classes due to a disciplinary problem, or should a parent display inappropriate behavior, the dancer may be expelled from Arkan Dance Company by the Artistic Director. The discipline of the classes and the consideration and determination of any expulsion shall be at the sole discretion of the Artistic Director. Expulsion is without consideration of refund.
- 12) **Costume Security Deposits:** A security deposit of \$2400 must be lodged in order to register for classes with Arkan Dance Company in the form of a signed Visa sales slip or 3 post - dated cheques, as listed on the front of this form. I agree to be fully responsible for any costumes that are lost or damaged. COSTUME SECURITY DEPOSIT AGREEMENT MUST BE SIGNED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.
- 13) **Returned Cheques & Overdue payments:** It is agreed that in the event that any cheques made payable to the Ukrainian Academy of Dance are returned by the Bank for any reason, the parent or dancer agrees to pay The Ukrainian Academy of Dance a \$20.00 service charge for handling the cheque so returned and that the funds owing to The Ukrainian Academy of Dance shall become payable immediately. Any payment that is overdue shall be subject to 2% interest per month.
- 14) **Timing of Registration and Payment of Fees:** I understand that no classes can be taken unless a completed registration contract is received and payment received in full.
- 15) **Costume Requirements:** If selected as a full member of Arkan or as an apprentice, dancers are required to own their own basic costume supplies as follows. This list may be added to at any time or changed during the dance season:
Girls must have their own: red boots, pink slippers, white slippers, white shorts, black shorts, baby skirt, bloomers, white bodysuit, skin-tone bodysuit, embroidered hutzul underskirt, silkscreen poltavski blouse, full Poltavski (velvet) costume with vinok, red ribbon, senior beads, embroidered blouse, embroidered underskirt, poyas, velvet zhupan, velvet apron, woven plachta; black or red character skirt, professional theatrical make-up kit including false eyelashes, fake hair braid.
Boys must own their own: red boots, professional theatrical make-up kit, sharavare, poyas, embroidered Poltavski shirt, silkscreen Poltavski shirt, black jazz shoes without holes.
- 16) **Attendance at Meetings and Participation in Fund-raising and other volunteer duties:** Dancers and parents are expected to attend all meetings and participate fully in fund-raising and other volunteer duties. It is understood that should adequate funds not be raised before a tour, parents and dancers may be expected to cover additional group costs over and above the dancer's individual travel costs. Non- participation in fund-raising will affect whether the dancer can participate in Arkan. Fund-raising participation is REQUIRED by all Arkan dancers and parents whether touring or not in that season.
- 17) **Use of Image:** For promotional purposes I agree that if my dancer's photo is chosen, I allow my dancer(s)' image to appear in promotional material (printed and/or website).
- 18) **Knowledge of French-braiding:** Female dancers must know how to French braid their own hair or someone else's in order to be an apprentice or full member of Arkan.
